Dear Friends,

I am writing this letter a few days before Christmas Day, when, with daily news on the spread of the Omicron variant and the cases rising, the newly announced 'Plan B' restrictions to prevent the spread of Covid have disheartened many. There is yet another challenging Christmas in front of us. The rising anxiety over Covid makes us feel devastated and hopeless again, making our future look uncertain and fragile.

In tough times, it can be really hard to speak with confidence and hope. The stress can be overwhelming. However, this week's passage from Isaiah, written when the Jewish people were in exile in Babylon, is therefore even more powerful. And Isaiah's message to the people from God is stunning: *Israel, the Lord who created you says, do not be afraid – I will save you. I have called you by name -- you are mine. When you pass through deep waters, I will be with you. Your troubles will not overwhelm you. When you pass through fire, you will not be burnt; the hard trials that come will not hurt you.* . . (GNB, Isaiah 43: 1-2).

The promises spoken in Isaiah 43:1-7 give assurance and comfort amid uncertainty to the people of Israel when they have been exiled and driven away from their homes, and do not know what is coming next. They have been waiting for a *really* long time. This has probably led to feelings of anxiety and deep disappointment.

Their time of captivity in Babylon would have been challenging in any number of ways. There would have been a temptation to abandon a god who had not protected them from captivity. In short, there would have been temptations to give up on the covenant that God had established with his people long ago.

Remember the words from Isaiah when you are far from home, when you've lost your way, or when you are afraid. In loss, in grief, in hope, God will be with you. The divine presence might just be enough to give you the courage and strength you need for whatever lies ahead.
