Later in the plan every church has at least one Local Arrangement please see this as an opportunity rather than a chore. I encourage you to try new things or to work as a team to bring your worship to God. Perhaps these are times for people to test a call to Worship Leading or Preaching. For Pentecost we hope to be able to do something together (and possibly outside).

We do not know for how much longer we will be required to have Risk Assessments and Socially Distanced Worship but at the time of writing these are still very much part of how we must live in these difficult times. It is therefore a requirement for any Church wanting to hold any activity including Worship to have a Risk Assessment which has been accepted by the Local Church Council. This Circuit Plan does not and cannot remove that need, but the CCAG are ready and able to help any church through the process of re-opening. May I take this moment to thank all those involved in re-opening churches for their time and diligence in making sure we are all safe.

In the time since starting to write the plan we have had good news about vaccines showing signs of working, and harder news about new variants. If I am honest I am starting to understand the child sat in the back seat of the car who asks the question, 'are we nearly there yet?' Of course none of us really know the answer. What I do know however is that God is travelling along with us. Sometimes calling us on, or urging us to move faster. At different times slowing us down and pleading that we simply rest and be with him rather than doing for him. Equally there are times when God laughs and cries with us and even when God carries us because we are too weak, tired, or afraid. May the journey of Lent and on through Easter allow you to find time and space to be with God, may you hear the voice of God calling you not into a plan but into a loving embrace with the one who created you. As we move towards Pentecost may you be filled to overflowing with the Holy Spirit, God present within you.
