As I write this letter I do so just as the Conference is about to meet and yet you will read it after it has adjourned for another year. There are a number of issues facing the church and this year's Conference will be asked to make decisions about some of these. The most publicized of these is the report, 'God in Love Unites Us', the conference will consider whether or not to allow people in same sex relationships to marry in a Methodist Church. Whilst this obviously raises passionate responses from those who have differing opinions, it is not the only report which will ask us to live together even though we don't agree on something. There are also reports considering whether Holy Communion can be celebrated online, or how we should alter our structures to allow a more streamlined approach to governance and oversight. Including the possibility of increasing the minimum number of Local Members needed to constitute a church with its own Church Council. The Conference will also consider a Statement (higher precedence than a report) which considers what Ministry in the Methodist Church (both Lay and Ordained) should look like for the next decade and beyond. All of this alongside the usual acceptance of the Stations, Budget, and so much more. There is much on which we might agree or disagree.

It has always been the case that we don't agree on everything. Indeed, I would offer that if we did agree on everything our denomination and world would be all the poorer for it. It is in our disagreeing that we find an opportunity to be creative and find new ways of being and working. It is in our diversity that I believe we can glimpse a little more of the mystery and majesty of God. You may have spent the last week blissfully unaware that the Conference was meeting, or you may have been glued to your computer screen watching it, or maybe like me somewhere in between. The Conference isn't the only place where we disagree. There is much in church life, even local church life where we find that we don't always have the same opinion, even as our friends or family. It is in our local churches that we find what it can really mean to be the body of Christ, agreeing on much and also agreeing to disagree. My experience of family has always been that dichotomy and yet that tension is held together not solely by our agreeing but because we are a family. I encourage you to spend some time thinking about those in the church and beyond who are wrestling with hard conversations and difficult decisions. Thanking God for all those who are in positions of responsibility, both in your local church, the denomination and beyond into the universal church and the whole world.
