All in all, this autumn ministerial resources in our circuit will be stretched.

To misquote an old strapline, "ask not what your minister can do for you, but what you can do for your minister". From time to time you probably already ask them how they are. Perhaps once in a while offer to take a task off their hands? We all know how a small act of kindness goes a long way. And as the laity, we need to take more responsibility for running our church. Show concern for our ministers' wellbeing. And above all hold them in our prayers.
