I hope you are well. I wonder if you find change threatening or refreshing? Invigorating or unsettling? A sign that the Spirit is actively at work in our lives or that traditions are being undermined? You may have thoughts about what your church (and circuit) should look like as we emerge from the pandemic. There are those things many long to get back to – like proper Methodist singing and coffee after the service! There are other things we've learnt in the past 18 months we may want to retain because they will still be useful, such as the weekly online and printed service.

Can we have the best of both worlds? I think so, yes. Some churches (eg Stratford) are upgrading their equipment to enable their Sunday services to be live streamed to those unable to attend. For meetings we may choose to have some in person and some, perhaps in the cold dark winter months, by zoom. The reduced need for heating and travelling also has environmental benefits.

Talking of meetings there is also the prospect of reducing their number, and also the number of people needed. A Circuit Meeting last month endorsed a vision of reducing the number of Church Councils from 15 currently to possibly as low as 6. This would happen by combining Church Councils. Each new Church Council would cover a number of churches. A major benefit is we would then need only 6 safeguarding officers, secretaries, treasurers etc rather than 15 of each. Of course, each of these roles would increase in size, but there will still be a significant overall saving in time. Those who decide to relinquish their current role may take the opportunity to do something different such as getting involved in outward looking activities. And of course it would increase our sense of being with other Methodists.

Which groups will form? This is for individual churches to decide, but one natural model would be to form groups around each of Stratford (incl Henley & Mickleton), Leamington (incl Dale St, Cubbington and Radford Road) and Warwick (incl Whitnash & Wellesbourne). A further grouping would consist of the rural chapels while Kenilworth and Stockton would continue as they are. As they say on tv, other solutions are available.

These are significant changes and the implications for each church will need to be worked through prayerfully. It is important to note that nothing will change at your church without the agreement of your Church Council. Similarly the timescale for these changes will depend on the churches themselves, although those with fewer than 12 members will need to consolidate by September 2022 because of a recent change in Methodist rules. If you have any questions please feel free to contact your church steward or any of the circuit stewards.

May we be guided in prayer by the Spirit in all we do as the church moves forward.
